Attempts by the Federal Member for Flynn to claim credit for the allocation of \$1.8 million of State funds for the Mt Perry road is political grandstanding at its dishonest worst.

The funding was from the State based "Safer Roads Sooner Program" and had nothing to do with Chris Trevor and yet he has been quick to get up and claim the credit.

The credit for this initial success rightfully belongs to the people of Monto who drove an extraordinary community campaign under the banner of "Monto to Mt Perry - No More Fatalities" to have something done about his road.
